



The 16' Ojibway has all the necessary attributes that a canoe should have: a rounded bottom, tumblehome for solo paddling, and the classic stem shape. Because of the popularity of our 17' 6" Ojibway, we designed a shorter version with completely new dimensions to fit the 16' length. Its' beautiful shape evokes thoughts of gliding on a lonely lake in the morning mist or in the evening calm.

- Beam: 31' - 1/4"
- Depth: 11' - 1/4"
- Rocker: 1 - 1/2"
