The Half Moon is a solo paddling canoe for smaller persons. It has a solid feel when leaned and its smaller wetted surface maintains equal hull speed with a lighter less strong paddler. It can be comfortably paddled sitting in the centre of the canoe and can be turned easily when slightly leaned. The above water line shape allow for increased final stability and increased paddling efficiency and comfort.
