



Canada's native heritage is reflected in the longnose of the Ojibway rice gathering canoe bow. Its' classic shape compliments the fine lines of the Ojibway canoe.

The 17'6" Ojibway is an excellent canoe for fishing, long distance tripping and family use. Its' shallow arch hull and length provides stability and its' fine entry lines give it good glide with each paddle stroke while maintaining a graceful and elegant look. Slight rocker makes for easy turning and excellent tracking. The fullness of the hull at paddling positions creates lots of foot room under the seats for kneeling paddlers. With a good bow height and high volume hull this canoe has lots of room for gear and extra passengers.
